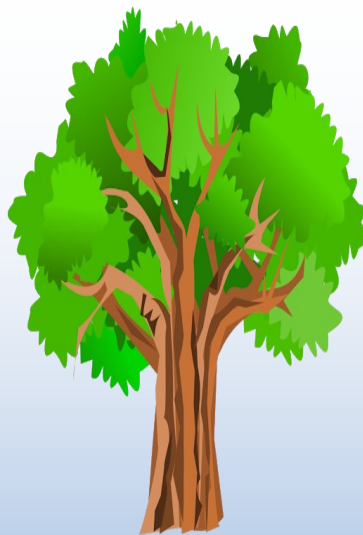
North Campus Community Garden

The North Campus Community Gardens are tilled and ready to plant. There are still (at the time of publication) 2—20 x 20 garden plots and 2—Mobility beds for the 2023 growing season. The Mobility beds are for those that want to garden but their mobility prevents them from gardening on the ground. The early bird gets the plot! Water fee for the 2023 season is 35.00 for the 20 x 20 and 17.50 for the Mobility Beds. Deposit fee for each plot is 25.00 cash. Tools are provided in the shed.

2/under FREE with paid adult (over 18 years). Must be in a swim diaper if not potty trained.

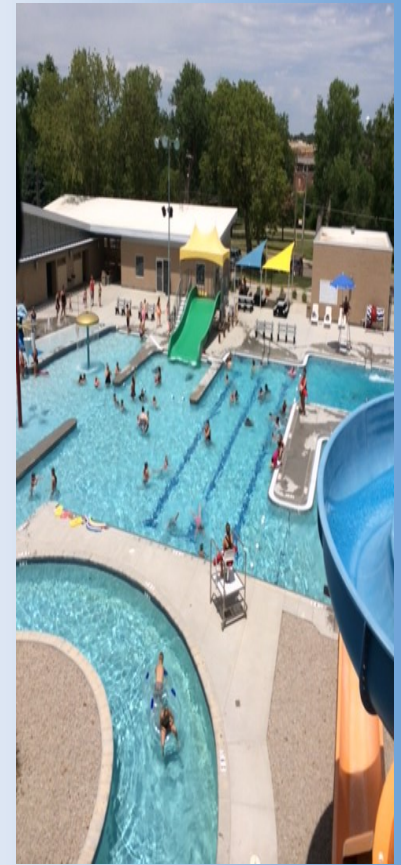
